Free Transportation

If you have no means of transportation to Plainsboro, but you have an appointment at the Bristol-Myers Squibb Community Health Center or the Medical Arts Pavilion, or need non-emergency care at the UMCP campus, the hospital will provide a free door-to-door transportation service.

To schedule a ride, call **609.853.6200** on weekdays from 8 am - 4:30 pm and on the two Saturdays each month when the Bristol Myers Squibb Community Health Center is open, from 9 am - 12 noon. **Please call at least 24 hours in advance and schedule a pickup time for at least 30 minutes before your appointment time.**
