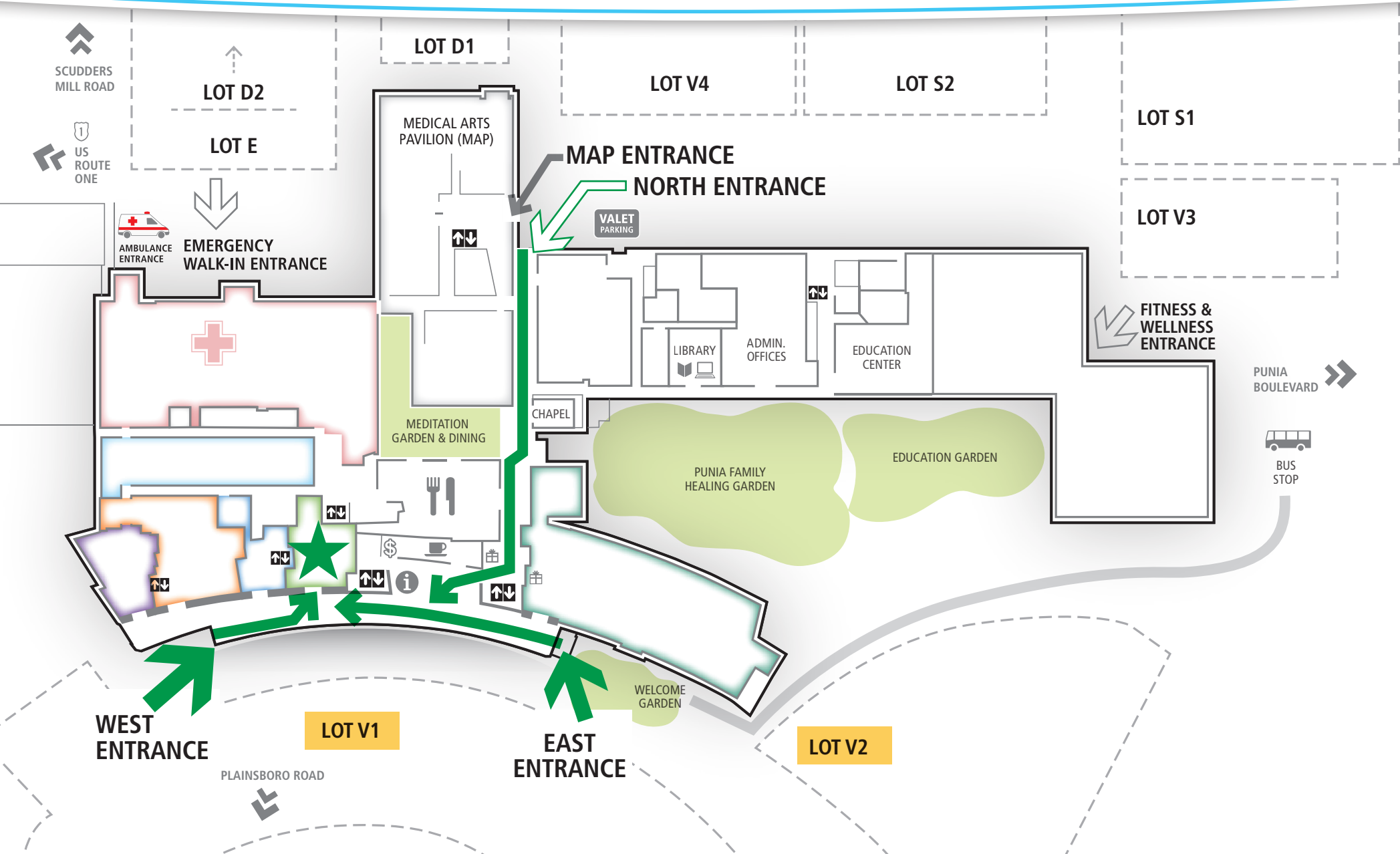

CLOSEST PARKING LOT:

V1 or V2, entrance via Punia Boulevard

- **Closest free self-parking** is available in the front of the hospital (the curved, silver building). Follow the signs for the Main Entrance and then look for the signs for V1 or V2.
- **Valet parking is available for a minimal charge on weekdays between 7:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. (See website for current pricing and additional information.)** It is accessible at the North Entrance of the hospital, which is next to the Medical Arts Pavilion entrance. The valet will drop you off at any entrance you choose. To reach the valet service, please call (609) 853-6963.
- **Handicapped parking** spaces are available. If you are unable to find a handicapped space, please use the valet parking service free of charge. To reach the valet service please call (609) 853-6963.
- **Please avoid parking in lots E or D2**, as these are closest to Emergency Walk-in Entrance.

CLOSEST ENTRANCES:

West Entrance, East Entrance

From Parking Lot V1 & V2:

- You can access the **Institute for Surgical Care** using the **West Entrance or the East Entrance**. If you are facing the front of the hospital—which is the curved, glass side of the building—the **West Entrance** will be on your **left** and the **East Entrance** will be on your **right**.
- The **Institute for Surgical Care** has green lighting at its entrance.

If you parked in lots V3, S1, S2, V4 or D1,

- Enter through the **North Entrance**, next to the **Medical Arts Pavilion** building.
- Continue walking straight past the **Chapel of Light** on your left and the **Restaurant** on your right.
- Turn **right** at the **gift shop** and walk toward the glass front **Main Lobby**.
- Use the first entryway on your right, which will be the Institute for Surgical Care. This entry way will have **green lighting**.

ONCE IN THE CENTER:

A Patient Access Associate will be there to greet you.
